Practical information

You can participate in an all-in weekend formula from Wednesday April 30 until Monday May 5 or from Friday May 2 until Monday May 5 2025, or in a oneday formula without food and lodging on Thursday May 1, Saturday May 3 or Sunday May 4, 2025. The maximum age for the participants is 28 years.

Registration costs are equal for everybody and amount to € 12 per person, ranging from a minimum of € 75 to a maximum of € 500 per group. The food and lodging expenses range from €175 to €295 for a stay from Friday to Monday or €292 to €492 for a stay from Wednesday until Monday, depending on the selected formula and accommodation.


